Proposed RHCC Bylaw Change

MONDAY, JANUARY 13 -- Noon - 7:00 PM

The Rolling Hills Country Club Board of Directors is submitting to the membership the following proposed Bylaw change to Article I, Section 7, Paragraph A in the Rolling Hills Country Club Bylaws regarding Directors Meetings.

Currently the Bylaw reads as follows:

A. The Board of Directors shall hold regular monthly meetings on the second (2nd) Monday of each month. The Presiding Officer may call special meetings whenever the need arises. Additionally, a meeting shall take place on the first day of November as an induction and organizational meeting of the new Board members. An election of the new officers will take place at this meeting.

If the proposed Bylaw change is approved, the Bylaw will read as follows:

A. The Board of Directors shall hold regular monthly meetings at a date and time that is most convenient for the Board and will notify the membership of the scheduled meeting at least one week prior. The Presiding Officer may call special meetings whenever the need arises. Additionally, a meeting shall take place on the first day of November as an induction and organizational meeting of the new Board members. An election of the new officers will take place at this meeting.

You may vote to keep the Bylaw as is with no change, or you may vote to change the Bylaw. One vote is permitted for each regular or company membership in good standing.
