POOL OPENS MONDAY, JUNE 29TH

YES !!!!! The pool season begins this Monday, June 29th. Come on out and enjoy the summer weather. Please do your part and comply with the following guidelines that have been put in place to keep our members and employees safe:

- Members only, no visitors.
- Temperature checks will be performed by lifeguards on everyone entering the pool area.
- Social distancing must be observed during check-in process.
- Masks are required anywhere six foot social distancing is not possible.
- Deck chairs must be six feet apart. Chairs for family members of the same household may be grouped together. Overflow chairs will be placed in the grassy area when necessary. Members may bring their own chairs. Towels will be required on all chairs.

- A distance of six feet must be maintained on the deck area and in the pool at all times unless you are members of the same household.
- When standing in line for the diving board, a distance of six feet must be maintained between swimmers.
- Please wash your hands prior to entering the pool area. In addition, hand sanitizer will be available pool side.
- To limit time in the restroom area, please dress in swimming attire prior to your arrival at the pool.
- Handrails will be cleaned by the lifeguards hourly. Bathrooms will be sanitized every two hours. Chairs will be sanitized daily.

CLUBHOUSE OPENS MONDAY, JUNE 29TH

YES !!!!! After 104 days, the Clubhouse is reopening. We will be observing social distancing guidelines. We ask that all members adhere to the following guidelines:

- Please wash your hands frequently. Hand sanitizer is available in the bar and bathroom areas.
- A distance of six feet should be maintained whenever possible. If social distancing is not possible, please wear a mask.
- Drinks will be ordered and served at one end of the bar. When standing in line, please stay six feet apart.
- Employees will be wearing masks and have their temperature checked. Temperature checks are available for members but not required.
- Tables and chairs will be set up six feet apart in the Clubhouse and on the deck. Tables and chairs will be cleaned between customers and at the end of the day.
- Coffee and popcorn will be served behind the bar -- no self-serve.
- If you are sick or have been around anyone who has been sick, please stay at home.
- Please do your part to keep our employees and members safe.
